

Minutes of the 81st Meeting of the Executive Committee of Gujarat Council of School Education - Samagra Shiksha (GCSE-SS)

The 81st Meeting of the Executive Committee of Gujarat Council of School Education was held at 1500 hrs. on 11th March 2026 for review and sanction of the activities for Samagra Shiksha under the Chairmanship of Shri Milind Torawane, IAS, Principal Secretary (Primary & Secondary Education), Education Department. The list of all the members present in the meeting is attached at **Annexure-A**.

Smt. Shilpa Patel, Secretary, Samagra Shiksha extended a warm welcome to the Chairman and all the members of the Executive Committee and started the proceedings of the meeting as per the agenda. The minutes of the meeting are as under:

Agenda 80.1 & 80.2: To accord sanction to the Minutes of the 80th meeting of E.C. (29.01.2026) & ATR on 80th EC Meeting

The Minutes of the 80th Meeting of E.C. held on 29th January 2026 along with the Action Taken Report (ATR) were reviewed and unanimously approved.

Agenda 81.3: Physical and financial progress under the Project Samagra Shiksha

The Committee noted that the PAB fund utilization till date was very low in all the Schemes, and it was directed to arrange a component-wise review of the Branches to review and expedite the fund utilization. It was directed to prepare model Request for Proposal (RFP) draft documents for planned and proposed interventions and once the budget is approved the tender should be published after following due approval process.

Committee noted component-wise poor performance of the respective District Coordinators as detailed in Annexure-B. Mentioned districts have not utilized funds in time bound manner as per the PAB approved annual plan for FY 2025-26.

Further, the Committee has also instructed to take appropriate measures to ensure the fund utilization within prescribed time-limits. The Committee noted Physical and Financial progress of Project Samagra Shiksha.

Agenda 81.4: To accord sanction for Tender for SITC of PA System with Automatic Bell at Various Govt. schools of Kheda, Vadodara, Ahmedabad, Mehsana, Gandhinagar, Surat, Morbi, Rajkot Districts

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and considering the operational requirements of the work, the Committee directed that it should be better handled in a decentralized manner. It was directed that respective funds/grants related to the PA System shall be allocated to the concerned Districts under the relevant Budget Head



for taking up the works as per the approved purchase policy of the State.

Agenda 81.5: Regarding establishing "PM SHRI Cell" at State Project Office under Gujarat Council of School Education (GCSE), Samagra Shiksha for implementation & monitoring of PM SHRI Schools

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and concurred the requirement of PM SHRI Cell to ensure the effective implementation and monitoring of the PM SHRI Schools, currently covering 889 schools (wherein 463 schools are from GoI-funds and 426 schools are from GoG-funds) and an additional 500 PM SHRI schools approved under the GoG budget for 2026–27.

The Committee accorded in-principle approval to the proposal. However, the approval of posts for the proposed cell shall be subject to obtaining necessary approvals from the Finance Department, Govt. of Gujarat. The Committee further directed that budgetary provision for the cell should be approved through the PAB & GoG budgets for the respective GOI and GoG schools, after which further action for establishment of the PM SHRI Cell shall be initiated.

Agenda 81.6: To accord sanction of purchase from National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (NIEPMD) for need based augmentation of the 687 Resource Room

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail for upgrading 687 Resource Rooms with specialized therapeutic equipment (such as Physio Balls, Trampolines, Standing Frames, etc.). The Committee noted that similar procurement been undertaken earlier from National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (NIEPMD), which is an autonomous national institute under Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwD), Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment (MoSJE), Government of India (GoI). The Committee further suggested that the procurement should be done as per the rules of General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017. The Committee accorded in-principle approval for the procurement of these items from the NIEPMD subject to procedural compliance.



Agenda 81.7: To accord sanction Establish Cell at the State Project Office under Gujarat Council of School Education (GCSE), Samagra Shiksha for the implementation & monitoring of Public-Private Partnership (PPP) residential school schemes.

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail. In-principle approval is accorded to the proposal. However, the approval of posts for the proposed cell shall be subject to obtaining necessary approvals from the Finance Department, Govt. of Gujarat. The Committee further directed that the budgetary provision for the cell shall be as per the approved GoG budget for the cell for FY 2026-27. Accordingly, further action for establishment of the cell for Public-Private Partnership (PPP) residential school schemes - Gyan Shakti Residential Schools (GSRs) & Swami Vivekanand Gyan Shakti Tribal Residential School of Excellence(GRTSE), shall be initiated.

Agenda 81.8: To accord sanction for the Tender to be floated to the Maintenance of Accounts for the F. Y. 2025-26

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and accorded sanction to publish the tender if required, for the Maintenance of Accounts for the financial year 2025-26 for the selection of Chartered Accountant firms, after completing all legal formalities.

Agenda 81.9: To accord sanction for tender for the repair, renovation and upgradation of main office building of Pathyapustak Mandal, Gandhinagar

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and accorded sanction for the tendering process of repair, renovation, and upgradation of the Pathyapustak Mandal (GSBSTB) main office building in Gandhinagar by Civil Branch as deposit work. Funds for the estimated cost of Rs. 12.84 Crore plus taxes are received from GSBSTB.

Agenda 81.10: To accord sanction for tender for 6950 Classrooms under sanctioned NABARD Loan 2025-26.

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail. In-principle sanction is accorded for various tender packages for the construction of 6,950 classrooms under the sanctioned NABARD Loan 2025-26, with a total estimated cost of Rs. 1403.90 Crore (including GST).



Further, the Committee directed that the initiation of tender process shall be taken up only after the issuance of the Government Resolution (GR), in this regard.

Agenda 81.11: To accord sanction for Procurement of Plastic Moulded Chairs in 2225 ICT labs and KGBV under Mission Schools of Excellence in various districts through GeM Portal.

The Committee returned the agenda.

Considering the operational requirements of the work, the Committee felt that it should be better handled in a decentralized manner. It was directed that funds/grants shall be allocated to the concerned Districts for taking up the works as per the approved purchase policy of the state.

Agenda 81.12: To accord sanction for work order to be released for the works of Construction /upgradation & construction of Hostels, DIETs of Excellence, Secondary Schools, KGBV-200/350/150/100 Cap., Model Schools

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and accorded approval for releasing work orders for 35 packages totalling Rs. 176.91 Crores. This includes 06 DIETs of Excellence, 01 Girls Hostel, 11 KGBV Extensions (100/150/200 capacity), 02 KGBVs (350 capacity), 02 Model Day Schools, 19 Secondary Schools.

The Committee noted that for the construction of DIET of Excellence buildings, 38 bidders were qualified and the work orders for 6 packages worth Rs. 29.95 Crore are to be issued. Similarly, for the construction / upgradation of 29 packages, 187 bidders were qualified and the work orders worth Rs. 144.12 Crore are to be issued.

Agenda 81.13: To accord sanction for work order to be released for third-party technical supervision, monitoring, and quality assurance for infrastructure work in various districts

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and accorded sanction for releasing work orders regarding third-party technical supervision, monitoring, and quality assurance of infrastructure works across various districts.



The Committee directed that the service charges for all qualified agencies shall be fixed at 2.8% of the estimated project cost. It was observed that some of the agencies do not give quality services once the specific district is allotted to them. Tendency of delaying assigned work is also observed due to assignment of specific district with monopolistic nature. In order to address this issue, a need was felt to have multiple agencies in each district.

Therefore, it was also directed that all qualified agencies shall form a common list of empaneled agencies, without assignment of any specific district to any particular agency. Specific work allotment shall be done by a computerized draw in a fair and transparent manner.

Agenda 81.14: To accord sanction for work order to be released for the procurement of Classroom Furniture (Benches) in Government Schools through GeM Portal under Mission school of excellence in various districts

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail.

The Committee noted that M/s Parin Enterprise Limited has been decided to be debarred as the supplies made by it were found not in conformity with the prescribed tender specifications.

Therefore, for one tender out of the four tenders under consideration, where M/s Parin Enterprise Limited emerged as L1 bidder, firstly L2 agency and later L3 agency may be approached to match the discovered L1 rates., subject to conformity of product specifications and other tender conditions. Said work may be allotted to the agency / agencies which agrees to match L1 rates with all tender conditions.

Approval was accorded for issuing work orders to L1 agency / agencies for the other 3 out of 4 new tenders, as per the agenda.

It was informed that there are some other undelivered works with the said agency i.e. M/s Parin Enterprise Limited. The committee directed that for the undelivered works with M/s Parin Enterprise Limited firstly L2 agency and later L3 agency may be approached to match the discovered L1 rates, subject to conformity of product



specifications and other tender conditions. Above mentioned works may be allotted to the agency / agencies which agree to match L1 rates with all tender conditions.

Agenda 81.15: To accord sanction for new policy approval for the empanelment of civil contractors under four categories for civil works tenders invited by Samagra Shiksha

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and to reduce the tender conclusion period, the Committee approved a new policy as mentioned in Annexure-C for the empanelment of Civil Works contracting agencies.

Salient features of the policy are as follow -

- There shall be four categories of Contractors based on estimated work amounts:
 - C Category - Up to Rs.150.00 Lakh
 - B Category - Rs.150.01 to Rs.300.00 Lakh
 - A Category - Rs.300.01 Lakh to Rs.700.00 Lakh
 - AA Category - Above Rs.700.00 Lakh
- This policy is aligned with the registration framework of the Road and Buildings (R&B) Department, GoG.
- Empanelment shall remain valid for the respective financial year. Additional validity of six (6) months is granted so as to enable the empaneled agencies to complete renewal by submitting latest records.
- Registration window for empanelment of agencies shall remain open throughout the year, to facilitate wider participation and empanelment of more eligible contractors in respective categories.
- Gujarat Council of School Education - Samagra Shiksha (GCSE-SS) shall complete renewal process within one month of submission of new application or renewal application for empanelment.



Agenda 81.16: To approve teaching and non-teaching Staff of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs) and Boys Hostels, Boys/Girls Hostels under PM JANMAN, Boys/Girls Hostels under DAJGUA, Boys Hostels under Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Avasiya Vidyalayas

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and accorded in-principle approval for a uniform staffing pattern across various residential schemes, aligning with existing KGBV norms.

However, the Committee directed that the creation and approval of the posts should be subject to obtaining necessary approvals from the Finance Department, Government of Gujarat. Further, the required budgetary provision shall be approved through the PAB and GoG Budget as applicable, after which necessary action for implementation shall be undertaken.

Agenda 81.17: Revision of Basic Pay of Teaching and Non- Teaching Staff of Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs) and Boys Hostels, Boys/Girls Hostels under PM JANMAN, Boys/Girls Hostels under DAJGUA, Boys Hostels under Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Avasiya Vidyalayas

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and accorded in-principle approval for the revision and enhancement of the basic pay structure.

However, the Committee directed that the creation and approval of the posts should be subject to obtaining necessary approvals from the Finance Department, Government of Gujarat. Further, the required budgetary provision shall be approved through the PAB and GoG Budget as applicable, after which necessary action for implementation shall be undertaken.

Agenda 81.18: Proposal for Approval of Formation of Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) Cell

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and concurred the requirement of a State-level ECCE Cell to strengthen Bal Vatikas and promote convergence with Anganwadis.



The Committee accorded in-principle approval to the proposal. However, the approval of posts for the proposed cell shall be subject to obtaining necessary approvals from the Finance Department, Government of Gujarat. The Committee further directed that budgetary provision for the cell should be approved through the PAB and GoG Budget as applicable, after which further action for establishment of the ECCE Cell shall be initiated.

Agenda 81.19: Approval for Opening of Separate Savings Bank Account in Indian Bank under Government of Gujarat (GoG) Scheme "Swami Vivekanand Gyan Shakti Residential School of Excellence (GCSE-SS)"

Committee directed to issue intimation to all nationalized banks and follow shortlisting procedure to finalize bank for the mentioned scheme.

Agenda 81.20: Approval for Opening of RBI-linked accounts for the implementation of following Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS)

The Committee accorded approval.

Agenda from Chair: 21 with the consent of the Chairman:

Agenda-81.21.1: Implementation of FDMS Portal in Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA)

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and accorded sanction for implementation of the FDMS Portal in Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) with the objective of strengthening financial management and monitoring mechanisms.

The Committee noted that necessary action has been initiated for issuance of work order for period of 5 years to M/s Alight Consultants Pvt. Ltd. for implementation and operational support of the FDMS Portal. It was further noted that the entire cost for implementation and operation of the FDMS Portal, maintenance of the system including required customization will be borne by Bank of Baroda, with no financial liability on GCSE-SS. Further, for smooth financial transactions, an Escrow Account will be opened with Bank of Baroda (BoB) as per the required financial mechanism.

The Committee also noted that the source code of the system will be kept in the Escrow Account, without any additional cost to GCSE-SS. Upon completion of the initial contract tenure of 5 years, a decision may be taken to extend the same on mutual consent basis.

MoU need to be signed between GCSE-SS and BOB for the implementation of FDMS.

Agenda-81.21.2: To accord sanction for a various package for construction of 2 KGBVs extension, 7 new Secondary Schools and repairing / extension in 10 Secondary Schools in various districts with total estimated cost put to tender of Rs. 43.58 Crore + Prevailing Taxes.

The Committee discussed the agenda in detail and accorded approval for publishing tenders for the proposed works comprising construction / extension of 2 KGBVs, construction of 7 new RMSA Secondary Schools, and repairing / extension works in 10 GoG Secondary Schools in various districts, with a total estimated cost of Rs. 43.58 Crore + prevailing taxes.

Agenda-81.21.3: To take note of Penal action and debarment.

Penalty and Debarment actions were taken against the following agencies which were placed on notice of EC:

1. Parin Enterprises Limited: The ongoing contract of the agency has been terminated, and the agency is debarred from participating in any future tenders for the next 5 years.
2. Satyam Construction Company: Penalty will be recovered from the RA Bills of the ongoing contract, and the agency is debarred from participating in any future tenders for the next 3 years.

Agenda-81.21.4: Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Implementation of Civil Construction works

The Committee observed delays for work initiation and lack of coordination. In order to address these issues, following Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) are suggested for Civil Construction works. State Project Director shall issue the SOP, after approval.



- Selected L1 Bidder shall be informed with signed copy of Letter of Acceptance (LoA) by Email immediately within two working days from the date of issuance of signed copy of the EC minutes.
- Work initiation meeting shall be intimated along with the LoA. Such work initiation meeting shall be called within 10 days, preferably following Monday from the issuance of LoA.
- Tender procedures such as Security Deposit by the L1 bidder and handing over the work order shall be completed during the work initiation meeting. Thus, work order issuance shall happen within two weeks from the date of issuance of the signed copy of the EC minutes.
- State Project Director is to send work order copy with a request covering letter to the concerned School Management Committee (SMC), with copy to respective District Development Officer. Such intimation letter shall have details of description of work, allotted budget, Selected agency, work completion period and other necessary details.
- SMC shall be requested to arrange foundation laying ceremony (Khatmuhurat) in the presence of local representatives and parents in order to ensure timely initiation of the work.
- Civil Branch to initiate the tendering process as per the prescribed procurement procedures and ensure timely implementation of the works.


The meeting then ended with vote of thanks to the Chair and the members.
